Academic Curriculum

Approved curriculum from National Curriculum and Textbook Board (NCTB) and text books prescribed by the Board will be followed. In addition to prescribed text books, supplementary books will also be introduced so as to widen knowledge and broaden outlook of the students. The syllabus will be streamlined for two terms and accordingly lesson plans will be prepared. Daffodil International College, Dhaka follows Board approved academic system for education and some more important Aspects with this system are given below:

Class XI :

The academic year is divided into two terms. In each term, at least two (2) monthly tests and at the Middle of the year, there will be half yearly exam and at the end of the year, year final exam will be administered. Monthly test will be held out of 25 marks and year final exam will be out of 75 marks. For Science Subjects having practical, all examinations will be administered out of 75 and 25 marks will be earmarked for practical examination.

Promotion:

For getting promotion from Class XI to Class XII, it is mandatory to have 90% attendance. Moreover, a student must obtain GPA 3.5 in each exam in science Group and GPA 3.00 in Business Studies Group.

Class XII:

Syllabus will be completed in two Terms. During the first term at least two (2) monthly tests and Pre-Test will be held. During the Second term at least two (2) monthly test and Test Exam will be held. The Selection Test to sit for the Board Exam will be held at the end of the second term. Result will be published in grading (GPA) system. Here mentioned that, if any student fails to achieve certain grade point (GPA) or do not have satisfactory attendance that is 90% presence in classes will not be able to participate in the Board Exam.

Lecture Sheet:

To make the class activities 100% effective, lecture sheet is provided to the students according to the necessity and importance. Thus from the beginning of the academic year each and every student can get an effective guideline for college exam as well as board exam.

Guide Teacher/Class Teacher:

Separate class teachers have been assigned for Science and Business Studies Group. Moreover, one teacher is assigned as guide teacher for 15/20 students. Guide teachers look after the students' regular study and give them proper motivation and advice for their overall development. They maintain regular communication with the parents.

Attendance in Classes and Examinations:

- In every term, each student must be present in 80% classes. Students will not be able to appear at Year Final Exam and Test Exam except 80% attendance.
- Prizes will be distributed among the students for 100% attendance the highest.
- If any student is absent due to any unavoidable reasons, application with the signature of parents or local guardian will be submitted. Late application will not be granted. Besides this, if he/she has been absent without permission, he/she will be fined Tk. 110 for each day.
- If any student becomes sick, he/she has to submit medical certificate and application with guardian's signature.

Syllabus:

After arranging the term schedule, syllabus is provided to the students so that students can get the clear outline about the activities of academic curriculum.

Number of Students in one section:

To make the lecture effective and fruitful maximum number of students per class is 50.

Class time:

Academic hour is from 8:30 am to 12:50 pm. Total five (5) classes are conducted daily and the duration of each class is 45 minutes. The Students' Tiffin time is 20 minutes.

Extra Class:

Due to political activities or any unexpected circumstances, extra classes are arranged.

Special Class:

Daffodil International College, Dhaka ensures the optimum use of its resources to facilitate academic excellence. Considering the need of the HSC examinees, Special Care Program and Model Tests after the Selection Test are arranged. It is mandatory to take part in the special classes and Model Tests for every student.

- ❖ 40% waiver in Monthly Tuition fees for GPA 4.5 Achievers in internal examination.

Special Notification:

- ◆ Monthly Tuition fee will have to be paid within 10th of the current month. If any student fails to pay within 10th of the current month, he/she will have to pay by 15th of the month with fine Tk 200. Again, if any student fails to pay within 15th, he/she will be fined Tk 500.
- ◆ In case of two months failure in paying tuition fees, a student will be fined the amount equal to one month.
- ◆ If any student fails to pay the monthly tuition fee for three (03) months consecutively, he/she has to get re-admitted. Re-admission fee is equal to one month's tuition fee.
- ◆ In class XI, all the dues up to June has to be paid before 1st Year Final Examination.
- ◆ After getting promotion to the next class, 2nd year admission fee has to be paid.
- ◆ In class XII, all the dues up to next June has to be paid before Selection Test for the public exam.

Admission cancellation:

College authority can cancel the admission of any student without warning him/her in following cases:

- ◆ Destroying any furniture or asset of the college.

- ◆ Bad manner and behavior.
